

- Pay for the program and sign in the educational agreement
- Take care of your visa and insurance
- Come at least one day before the start of the program

PROGRAM FEE

The Program fee is 1100 EUR. It includes accommodation in a double standard room, catering (breakfasts, coffee breaks and lunches), and cultural program
