The monography is supposed to bring/compare new outcomes/findings from the Czech and international universities (comparative analysis) reflecting the topics discussed at the workshops. For the purpose of the monography certain hypotheses will have to be answered in the papers (or it is possible to first determine a hypothesis to a given topic that will be later discussed).

Hypotheses:
