Welcome to the Erasmus+ OLS language assessment.

You are requested to complete this language assessment in the language you will use to study, work or volunteer during your Erasmus+ mobility. By completing this assessment, you can find out what your current language level is.

The online assessment takes approximately 40 to 50 minutes and consists of five sections with a total of 70 questions:


- ► Grammar (20 questions)
- ► Vocabulary (15 questions)
- ► Key communicative phrases (15 questions)
- ► Listening comprehension (10 questions)
- ▶ Reading comprehension (10 questions)

The questions are progressively adapted to suit your language level so don't worry if the questions suddenly become easier or more difficult.

We advise you to take the assessment in a quiet environment with a stable internet connection. At any moment during the assessment, you can save and continue later, but keep in mind that once you have completed the assessment and received the results, you cannot do it again.
